A Movement for Hope

Through the power of community, i-ACT coordinated the creation of Darfur United, an all-refugee men's soccer team made up of Darfuri refugees living in camps in eastern Chad. In 2012, the team overcame all obstacles to travel from isolated refugee camps to participate in the Viva World Cup in Iraqi-Kurdistan. Upon hearing news of the formation of Darfur United, a refugee leader from Camp Kounoungo, said, "now we are a part of the world."

Not only is Darfur United an opportunity for the refugees to represent their people and play, it's a movement to bring hope, inspiration, and joy to the displaced people of Darfur. Refugees now feel they have something to call their own despite being homeless and waiting for peace for more than a decade. The younger generation is now motivated to play, train, and hope for something beyond the confinement of their camp.

The team is also a vehicle for global social awareness. The team's story brings the grave issues such as homelessness and war to a large audience through a relatable story of a team's journey to a competition.

This year the team has been invited to participate again. This time on a larger and more prestigious stage in Östersund, Sweden.

The Confederation of International Football Associations (ConIFA) is the leading organization for all the football teams outside of FIFA. ConIFA organizes the official World Football Cup, Continental Championships, and International tournaments, combined with cultural events and youth exchanges for teams from isolated regions and communities.
